## **Lord Of The Harvest**

And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. *Mathew* 9:35-38

Here are some exciting testimonies.

I participated in an historic evangelistic initiative in Jerusalem with a large number of Messianic Israeli believers and we hit the streets of Jerusalem with the gospel. There were many salvations and healings. I personally prayed with several Israeli Orthodox men to receive their Messiah with sincere hearts. As I was preparing to extend my trip in the land, the Lord gave me a dream confirming that He wanted me to return to Thessaloniki for the Israel-Greece monthly prayer that I help organize and facilitate. So I obeyed and the prayer meeting was the most passionate we have had to date!

As I waited at Ben Gurion airport for my flight, a woman was rolled in next to me in a wheelchair with a medical mask covering her face. I started a conversation. She turned out to be a Greek Jew from Athens who goes to Israel for cancer treatments and will have a serious operation soon. She was totally open, received Yeshua, prayer for healing and took my phone number to let me know how her surgery goes. When I saw her at baggage claim, her face was unmasked and glowing with the glory of God!

I met R and B, an Israeli couple, in Berea trying to enter the famous Berean synagogue, but the doors were locked and the overseer was not there. I offered to give them the history myself. I wove the story of the Greek Jews of WWII, the Apostle Paul and the gospel all together. At first they were quite guarded, but suddenly the love of Yeshua broke through, their hearts opened and they received the New Testament and prayer and told me to visit them when I return to the land. They took my email and sent me a photo of us all together. So many Jewish hearts are softening, opening like a beautiful ripe flower.

I passed by to see M, the cafe owner in Thessaloniki who Claudia and I prayed for a year ago who had excruciating leg problems. He is only 32 years old! When I saw him, I couldn't believe it was the same person. He was completely healed the day we prayed, is still healed and moving around freely and painlessly!

When I met T, a devout Greek Orthodox, last year in a neighborhood shop, he was very suspicious of me every time I spoke about Jesus. One day on the train from Athens, I shared with a woman whose heart was very tender to the Lord. When I told her where I lived, she asked if I shopped in the store where her son worked. It turned out to be T! When I walked in the shop a few days later, T had already received a call from his mom telling him how she met me. After that he started listening to me. A few months ago, I walked in to find him in excruciating back pain. He was scared and desperate. I prayed for healing in the name of Jesus and when I returned some days later, he was completely healed! When I saw him a week ago, he said his back continues to be fine but his neck is still quite painful and stiff. So we prayed. When I returned a few days later, he met me with a huge smile. His neck was healed! Now he's pinned to everything I say about Jesus! I am believing the Lord to save T and use him for his glory. He is a big zealous fish getting ready to be reeled in!

My German friend, Sylvie, flew in to help me recently. We saw numbers of souls come to the Lord. As we preached, worshiped with guitar, many youth, Greek Orthodox, shop owners and more opened their hearts to hear and several accepted the Lord.

One day, we were invited to a refugee camp to the room of a Syrian Moslem family. Two others came, one Moslem and one a new Christian who spoke English. As we were having tea, the Spirit of the Lord came upon me to preach the powerful gospel! The gospel pierced their heart and all three accepted Jesus as their Lord and Savior. Visible joy broke out in their hearts and in the room. The husband later cried out, "I can't wait to get away from the Moslems. Then I'll rip the head covering off my wife and throw it in the garbage!" The other young man has already attended a church with my translator!

Then he says to his disciples, "The harvest truly is plenteous, but the laborers are few; Pray therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth laborers into his harvest." *Mathew 9:38* 

Precious saint, please pray for more souls and more workers. Another team is coming from Germany in May. Pray for more teams to come and walk in the footsteps of Paul. Our Israel-Greece Bridge prayer meetings continue to grow in unity and passion as we go from church to church monthly. This is already bringing a great blessing. There is more on the horizon.
